“Vocation” from the Latin word “vocare” meaning “a call”. Work is a man’s call to serve God.

“ Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men... It is the Lord Christ who you serve. **Colossians 3:23-24**”

“ God blessed them; and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it...” **Genesis 1:28**”
