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- **B.** God's plan for your children is generational **obedience** and **prosperity**.



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Your Children Need an Example—Dad, You're It!

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- A. Men, leadership begins with being an example.
 - Parenting begins with <u>modeling</u>. Modeling has priority over telling. We must live out certain things before our children.
- **B.** Moses tells the men of Israel to be examples of two things. We are to be the visible, bodily example of two loves. Let's make that more personal. Men, you and I are to be an example of two things two loves:
 - Love the <u>Lord</u>...

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- And love His Word...
 - Do you meditate on His Word? Do you read it? Memorize it? Study it and share it?

Your Children Need a Teacher—Dad, You're It!

- **A.** What does the author mean by "teach them diligently?" The word "teach" means to "impress." It was often used of an artist or engraver, with hammer and chisel, etching a text or image into the face of a granite slab. Fathers, we are to similarly chisel the principles of God's Word onto the hearts and minds of our children.
 - This "impressing" is both <u>systematic</u> and <u>spontaneous</u>.



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 - Notice that the spiritual formation of our children is a <u>constant</u> activity.
 You talk to them:
 - 1. When you sit.
 - 2. When you walk.



- 3. When you lie down.
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- **C.** There is greater distance in the home today in the American culture than there ever has been anywhere.
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- **C.** There is greater distance in the home today in the American culture than there ever has been anywhere.
 - We must remember that error increases with distance.
 - You cannot parent effectively from a <u>distance</u>. If I am going to be a good father, I must be with my children early and often.



Your Children Need a Teacher—Dad, You're It! Continued...

• As men, we must figure out how to minimize that distance. No one else in this world will **fight** that distance for your family. You must do it.





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 - 1. Hand = Actions
 - 2. Forehead = Attitudes



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 - 1. Your actions and attitudes must both conform to God's truth.
 - 2. Your private and public life must be consistent with God's truth.

- **B.** Our word "integrity" stems from the Latin word 'integer' which means whole and complete (an integer is a whole number—no fraction). Integrity requires a 'wholeness' or consistency of character.
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 - Moses is saying there must be <u>integrity</u> (or wholeness) in your life with respect to God's Word.
 - Inconsistency in these is **hypocrisy**, and it sends a twisted message to your children.



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 - 4. Preaching holiness but practicing worldliness.
 - 5. Preaching forgiveness but harboring resentment.



- **C.** God's plan is for generational prosperity. He intends our children to learn from us to obey His Word and experience the prosperity of covenant blessing.
 - Men, that begins and ends with you. Your example. Your <u>instruction</u>. Your proximity. And your integrity. You're just the man for the job.





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 - What is a father's <u>blessing</u>? A father's blessing is giving authorization and empowering your children to grow in Christlikeness.
 - The father's blessing is not only words of affirmation but intentional instruction that will set a child on the right <u>path</u>.
 - IMPORTANT: True blessings are not tied to <u>performance</u> or a life event!

- B. You see these types of blessings throughout Scripture:
 - These blessings were always intended to pass primarily through the **father!** Nothing compares to a Father's Blessing!
